 - c. An accessory: sword, hook, musket, skull and crossbones flag, or parrot.
 - d. Appropriate shirt: striped shirt, white t-shirt or shirt.
 - e. Appropriate trousers: pantaloons, tatty trousers or rolled-up trousers.
